

REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 5, 2007, 5:30 P.M.
CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The City Council of Newton, Iowa met in regular session at 5:30 P.M. on the above date in the Council Chambers at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Allen presided. Present: Council members Foreman, Morgan, Hansen, Mullan, Ewing. Absent: None.

There was no citizen participation.

Moved by Mullan, seconded by Ewing to approve the consent agenda. AYES: Five. NAYS: None. Motion carried to approve the consent agenda.

Mayor Allen stated now was the time and the place for a public hearing on the Resolution Adopting The 2007-2008 Operating Budget For The City Of Newton. There had been no written comments. There was no citizen input. Moved by Hansen, seconded by Mullan to close the public hearing. AYES: Five. NAYS: None. Public Hearing closed. Moved by Mullan, seconded by Hansen to Introduce a Resolution Adopting The 2007-2008 Operating Budget For The City Of Newton. AYES: Five. NAYS: None. Resolution No. 2007 – 024 adopted.

Under new business Hansen stated he had several calls from citizens and on behalf of them and himself he wanted to thank everyone who helped out with the ice storm. Mayor Allen read part of a news release regarding a new grant that the City had been awarded to help displaced workers. Morgan thanked the Mayor and everyone who had helped Newton to get this grant. Mullan noted that the Triple A, March-April 2007 magazine had a nice article on Newton.
