

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 11, 2008, 12:00 P.M.  
CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The City Council of Newton, Iowa met in special session at 12:00 P.M. on the above date in the Council Chambers at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Allen presided. Present: Council members Plumb, Hansen, Ewing, Foreman, Morris, Mullan. Absent: None.

Moved by Hansen, seconded by Plumb to Introduce a Resolution Ending Employment Agreement With City Administrator. AYES: Six. NAYS: None. Resolution No. 2008 – 037 adopted.

Moved by Foreman, seconded by Ewing to go into Closed Session To Evaluate The Professional Competency Of An Individual Whose Appointment, Hiring, Performance Or Discharge Is Being Considered When Necessary To Prevent Needless And Irreparable Injury To That Individual's Reputation And That Individual Request A Closed Session. Pursuant To The Provisions Of Section 21.5(1)(i), Code of Iowa 2007. AYES: Six. NAYS: None. Mayor Allen called for a five-minute recess to clear the council chambers.

Upon return to open session at 12:28 p.m. with all council members present a motion was made by Foreman, seconded by Ewing to Introduce a Resolution Approving Contract For Interim City Administrator. AYES: Six. NAYS: None. Resolution No. 2008 – 038 adopted.

Darrin Hamilton, City Attorney / Acting City Administrator stated he had been asked by Chair of the Employee Relations Committee to contact Jim Brimeyer, President of The Brimeyer Group to see if he would be available to visit with the committee on Monday, April 14, 2008 @ 4:00 p.m. The Employee Relations Committee would then make a recommendation to the full city council.

It was noted the Council goal setting session set for April 14, 2008 was postponed.

Moved by Hansen, seconded by Plumb to adjourn the meeting at 12:33 p.m. Motion unanimously carried by voice vote.
