

NUISANCE STUDY SESSION MINUTES
JUNE 2, 2008 4:30 P.M.
CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The City Council of Newton, Iowa met at 4:00 p.m. on the above date in the Council Chamber at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Allen presided. Present: Council members Plumb, Hansen, Ewing, Foreman, Morris, Mullan. Absent: None.

Interim City Administrator/Police Chief Thomas Wardlow started the meeting with an overview of the nuisance initiative.
