

BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 03, 2020 7:03 PM
CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The City Council of Newton, Iowa met in special session for a budget workshop at 7:03 p.m., on the above date in the Council Chambers at 101 West 4th Street South. Mayor Hansen presided. Present Council Members: Hallam, Stonner, George, Ervin, Trotter, Mullan. Absent: None.

Matt Muckler, City Administrator, began with an introduction. Council was given an opportunity to comment on General Fund Non-Salary Expenditures and Non-Salary Expenditures for all other funds such as Partner Organization Funding and the Capital Improvements Program. There were no comments.

Public Works Director, Jody Rhone presented on the Storm Water Utility proposal.

During the final review of the budget, Library Board Chair, Tom Hollander, the reductions the Library has made and asked the council to allow the amount for the retiree vacation payout for the Assistant Director to be carried over from FY20 to FY21. Council discussion ensued. There was consensus to allow for the payout in FY21 using FY20 undesignated funds and a FY21 budget reduction.

Moved by George, seconded by Trotter, to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 p.m. Motion unanimously carried by voice vote.
